Summary

This bill creates the Ohio Council on Transportation Technology to recommend state policies on autonomous technology.

Business Impact

If you operate in transportation technology in Ohio, you must stay informed about new policies from the Council or risk non-compliance with state regulations.

Key Provisions

- Establishes the Ohio Council on Transportation Technology.
- Council to make recommendations on state policies regarding autonomous technology.
- Focuses on transportation technology, including autonomous vehicles.
