Regulate autonomous vehicles

Last Action (Nov 10, 2016): Refer to Committee: Transportation and Infrastructure

Summary

This bill authorizes manufacturers of autonomous vehicles to operate on public roads under specified requirements and mandates a report on safety regulations.

Business Impact

If you manufacture autonomous vehicles in Ohio, you must comply with operational requirements or face penalties.

Key Provisions

- Authorizes manufacturers to operate autonomous vehicles on public roads.
- Establishes specified requirements for operation.
- Mandates a report from the Director of Transportation on safety regulations.

Compliance Checklist

- Ensure compliance with operational requirements for autonomous vehicles. | Who: Manufacturers of autonomous vehicles | Penalty: Potential penalties for non-compliance.
- Prepare for regulatory changes based on the Director's report. | Who: Manufacturers and operators of autonomous vehicles | Penalty: To be determined based on future regulations.
