Summary

AB1337 amends the Information Practices Act of 1977, including Section 1798.24. Verification of changes to 'personal information' in Section 1798.3 is pending full bill text.

Business Impact

If you handle personal data, ensure compliance with new disclosure rules or face disciplinary action.

Key Provisions

- Verification needed for changes to Section 1798.3 regarding 'personal information.'
- Revises conditions for disclosing personal information (Section 1798.24).
- Includes Sections 1798.24b, 1798.25, 1798.26, 1798.27, 1798.29, 1798.44, 1798.55, 1798.57, and 1798.68 in the amendments.

- Revise data handling practices to comply with expanded definitions | Who: Local agencies | Penalty: Potential disciplinary action for violations
